3. got diseases from the French.

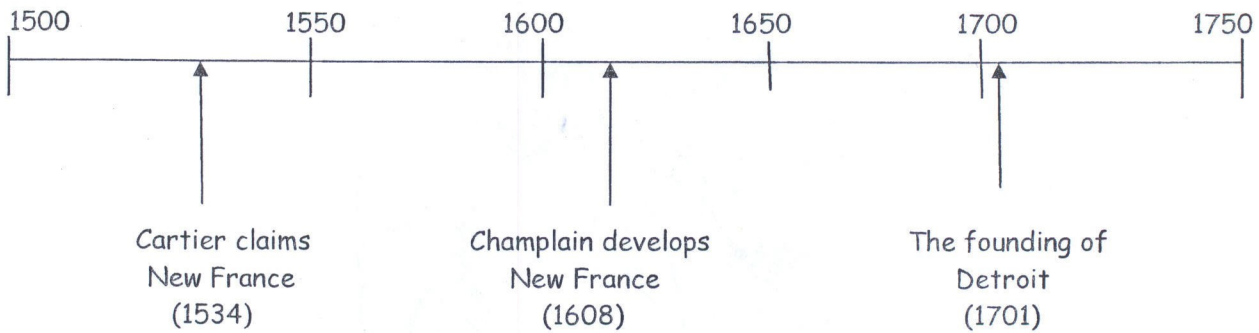
5. What is a voyageur?

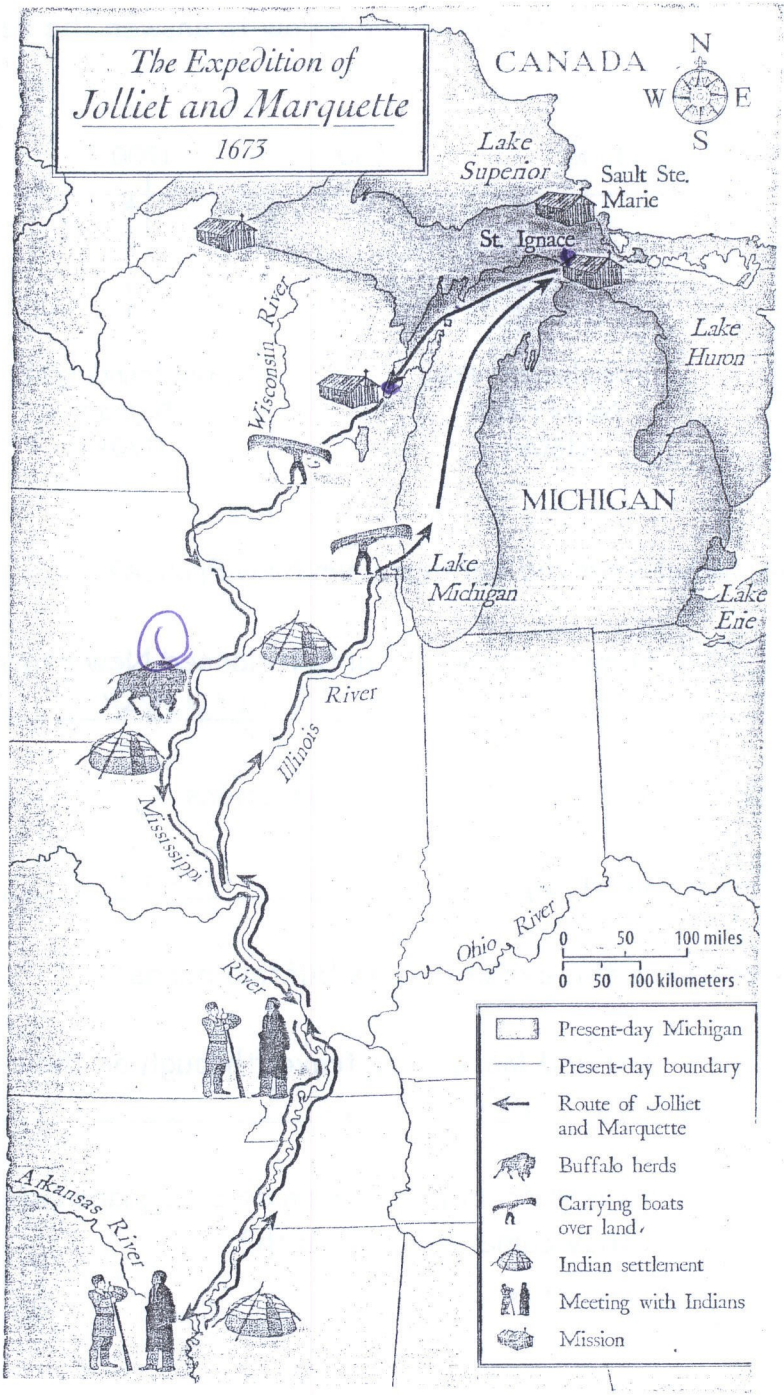
9. Look at the time line. How many years after Cartier claimed New France did Champlain start to develop New France? 74 years
